5.	<p><b>Morphology. Spelling</b> <b>Noun</b> Noun as a part of speech: general meaning, morphological features, and syntactic role. Common and proper, specific and abstract nouns. Capital letter and quotations in proper nouns Collective nouns. Noun gender. Noun number.</p>



	<p>Noun cases. Vocative case. Noun declension. Division of nouns by declensions and groups. Spelling of compound nouns.</p>
6.	<p><b>Adjective:</b> meaning, morphological signs, and syntactic role. Groups of adjectives by meaning: qualitative, relative, and possessive. Transfer of adjectives from one group to the other. Degree of comparison of qualitative adjectives and their composition. Declension of adjectives. Hard and soft groups of adjectives. Transition from adjectives to nouns. Formation of adjectives. Spelling of adjectives. Spelling of attributive surnames.</p>
7.	<p><b>Numeral:</b> meaning, morphological signs, and syntactic role. Cardinal and ordinal numerals. Simple, complex, and compound numerals. Declension of numerals. Spelling of numerals. Concord between the numerals and the nouns. Correct use of numerals indicating date and time.</p>
8.	<p><b>Pronouns:</b> meaning, morphological signs, and syntactic role. Groups of pronouns by meaning: personal, reciprocal, possessive, demonstrative; interrogative and relative; negative; definite and indefinite. Declension of all groups of pronouns. Spelling of pronouns. Spelling of pronouns separately from prepositions.</p>
