4.	<p><b>One-member sentence.</b> <b>Simple one-member sentences</b> with the main member <b>as a predicate</b> (definite personal, generalized personal, indefinite personal, and impersonal) and <b>subject</b> (nominal). One-member sentence as a part of a compound sentence. <b>Complete sentences and ellipses.</b> Dashes in ellipses.</p>
5.	<p><b>Simple expanded sentence.</b> <b>Sentence with homogenous parts.</b> <b>Homogenous parts of a sentence.</b> Common and uncommon homogenous parts of a sentence. Colon and dash with generalizing words in sentences with homogenous parts.</p>
6.	<p><b>Sentence with an address and expletive words (phrases, sentences).</b> Common and uncommon addresses. Rhetoric address. Expletive words. Punctuation of addresses and expletive words.</p>
7.	<p><b>Sentence with detached parts.</b></p>



	Concept of detachment. Detached secondary parts of sentence. Punctuation of detached parts of sentence.
